Subject: Gazette of Pakistan S.R.O. 1161 (I)/2016

Enclosed, please find for appropriate action, a copy of the Gazette of Pakistan Statutory Notification **S.R.O. 1161 (I)/2016**, dated 14 November 2016 regarding United Nations Security Council Sanction measures concerning South Sudan under chapter VII of the charter of the United Nations. The annexed order includes **amendment changes** made to the listed entity in the South Sudan Sanctions Committee List. Restrictions with respect to assets freeze, travel ban and arms embargo *shall remain intact*. The latest S.R.O updates our previous Gazette Notification S.R.O. No. **620 (I)/2016 dated 22 June 2016**.

2. In pursuance of the UN Security Council Resolution No. 2206 (2015) and its subsequent resolutions, SROs are issued by the Government of Pakistan whenever the Consolidated List maintained by the South Sudan Sanctions Committee is updated.

ORDER

S.R.O. ¹¹⁶¹(1)/2016– WHEREAS the United Nations Security Council vide its Resolutions Nos. 2206 (2015), 2271 (2016), 2280 (2016), 2290 (2016) and all relevant resolutions concerning South Sudan have directed to apply travel restrictions and to freeze the funds and other financial resources of certain individuals and entities under Chapter VII of the United Nations Charter;

AND WHEREAS the United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948 (XIV of 1948) enjoins upon the Federal Government to apply certain measures for giving effect to the decisions of the United Nations Security Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2 of the United Nations (Security Council) Act, 1948 (XIV of 1948), the Federal Government is pleased to order that the individuals and entities listed in the Annexure to this order *reflecting the updates made by the South Sudan Sanctions List* of the United Nations Security Council in addition to the earlier notifications, shall stand subjected to the travel restrictions and assets freeze in accordance with the aforesaid Resolutions with immediate effect.
