NEXT Web Based Trading Terminal Security Settings

In continuation to our circular PMEX/Operations/ 36-2011 dated November 23, 2011 wherein we had notified to all our brokers about the introduction of GTC order type and NEXT web based trading terminal security configuration.

Subsequent to successful mock trading results, on Monday November 28, 2011 we noticed that brokers did not change their web browser settings as notified in the said circular result in broker and their clients faced serious problems in placing orders at PMEX.

Brokers are requested to inform their house Users and clients about the said changes and ensure that these settings are in place by Friday December 02, 2011. Otherwise they will not be able to place orders at PMEX.

- 1. Licensed Windows XP Professional with SP3 and with latest OS Patches.
- 2. Internet Explorer 8.0 with latest patches.
- 3. Port 80, 443 and 9090 must be open on firewall, if firewall is installed.
- Internet Explorer Temporary Internet Files and History Settings must be set to option as "Every time I visit the webpage". Setting Menu path: Explorer Menu Tools>Internet Options>General>Browsing History settings
